Your cruise will take you to the main points of interest in Tierra del Fuego: the Strait of Magellan, the Beagle Channel, Cape Horn, glaciers and National Parks. You will experience and explore each of these wondrous locations in well-equipped Zodiacs, stepping ashore, where possible, to discover more. All expeditions are led by guides who are experts in local geography, cultural history, flora and fauna.

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In addition, there are special departures every season focused on whale watching or that follow in the steps Charles Darwin's voyage through the territory. There are also photographic safaris, and a program that complements the cruise with a land tour through Tierra del Fuego, including a visit to a King Penguin colony.

■ MOTHER NATURE'S FINEST

Enjoy stunning topography, bordered by towering glaciers, native forests, and inhabited by exotic flora and fauna, while navigating through uniquely beautiful channels.

We are privileged to operate our adventures through this spectacular and untouched scenery, in one of the few uninhabited areas on the planet. In acknowledgement of the privilege, we have created a number of initiatives to minimize the impact of our operations, avoiding mass tourism and promoting a series of practices onboard and on expeditions, so that these precious locations are cared for, respected, and maintained.

All expeditions are guided by experts who have been trained to inform and educate based on science, providing recommendations to passengers to ensure minimal 'footprint' during each landing.



■ THE INHABITANTS OF PATAGONIA

Along with the dramatic geography of the southernmost tip of Patagonia, during your trip you will visit the habitat of large colonies of sea lions and elephant seals, beavers, whales, and dolphins.

Be prepared to be amazed by the vast amount of Patagonian birds which includes different species of gulls and terns, giant petrels, cormorants, albatrosses, condors, and ducks, as well as one of the most important colonies of Magellanic Penguins (Spheniscus Magellanicus) in the Southern Hemisphere.

■ CAPE HORN, WHERE TWO OCEANS MEET

Cape Horn was declared a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 2005 and is crowned by a 7-meter high steel monument symbolizing an albatross.

Located in the Tierra del Fuego archipelago, this legendary landmark, considered the world's most southerly point, was discovered in 1616, and for centuries was an important navigation route between the Pacific and Atlantic oceans.

Cape Horn, often called 'The end of the world', is a place that evokes strong emotional and spiritual feelings among visitors. Its location between two oceans and the intensity of the surrounding atmospheric phenomena will make your visit a unique and unparalleled experience.

LIFE ONBOARD AUSTRALIS

Australis offers continental cuisine with buffet lunches and 4-course-set-dinners with two main course choices. We work to cater to various special diet requests. The bar, which also operates an all-inclusive system, features an international menu and a wide selection of liquors and wines where the favorite is the Calafate Sour.

Passengers also have access to a library with extensive literature on the flora, fauna, and history of the region as well as board games and other onboard entertainment activities.

At the end of every day, the guides deliver a brief presentation on the following day's activities and share their extensive knowledge of Tierra del Fuego.

The official languages onboard are Spanish and English. Guided tours in French and German are available for a minimum of 15 passengers per language. Please ask us if you have other language requirements and we will do our best to assist you. There is also a store and prepaid satellite phone onboard.

Equipment

Expedition Cruises

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
